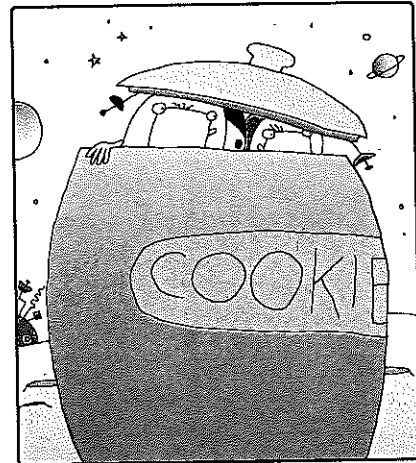


Pronouns and Antecedents 2
