


# Apostrophes 3

Apostrophes can be used in your writing to show possession—to say, “Hey, that belongs to me!” (Turn to 402.5-403.4 in *Write Source 2000* for more details about how to use apostrophes to show possession.)

## EXAMPLES

### *Singular Possessives:*

**Cedar Point's Mean Streak roller coaster is one of the world's longest wooden coasters.**



### *Plural Possessives:*

**The visitors' hearts raced as they plunged down the coaster hills.**

### *Shared Possession:*

**Latoya, Eli, and Gabriel's favorite roller coaster is the Wild Thing at Valleyfair.  
Latoya's, Eli's, and Gabriel's favorite snacks are different.**

### *Possessives in Compound Nouns:*

**My sister-in-law's biggest fear is falling out of a roller coaster.**

### *Possessives with Indefinite Pronouns:*

**Everyone's hands grab the safety bar during loops.**
