civil war	<i>Noun</i>	conflict between groups in the same country or nation.
emigrant	<i>Noun</i>	person who moves from their existing country or region to a new country or region.
human migration	<i>Noun</i>	the movement of people from one place to another.
immigrant	<i>Noun</i>	person who moves to a new country or region.
refugee	<i>Noun</i>	person who flees their home, usually due to natural disaster or political upheaval.
resettlement	<i>Noun</i>	transportation of people to a new residential area, usually following a natural or man-made disaster.
